Transition Program

First sessions: Friday 7th November
Time: 9am to 11.00am

What to bring: A hat and a water bottle.
Students will meet teachers and be shown some of the routines of the classroom such as where their bags go, the reading area, games area, toilets and junior playground. Students will participate in a range of fun activities. They will be given morning tea before being picked up at 11am.



Second session: Friday 21st November
Time: 9am to 11.20am

Students will again spend the session familiarising themselves with the school and teachers. They will continue to learn some of the routines and socialise with their new classmates. Morning tea will be served in the classroom before students go outside for a play.
